This one-day course instructs attendees in the proper use of the coding manual, gives a knowledge of basic coding conventions and guidelines, and introduces the crucial concepts of sequencing, manifestations and case-mix diagnoses. Getting the basics right is the first step in coding accuracy. This course emphasizes the official coding guidelines, Chapter 3 of the OASIS Implementation Manual, Appendix D and other official guidance. The program will provide the "background" of why we have to do what we do. Common coding errors will be identified and rectified--overuse of V codes; sequencing issues; missing 5th digits are just a few. Updated to include any CMS changes regarding ICD-9-CM coding, this full-day workshop is designed for beginner coders who have a basic understanding of home health and OASIS.
